The CREative, REinspiring, Virtual RE Conference on Wednesday 26th March 2025. This highly enjoyable virtual day conference is put together by a working party from all 3 SACREs and with input from RE Advisers from Wiltshire, Dorset and BCP and from Salisbury, Bristol and Winchester and Portsmouth dioceses. **This year's themes and a timetable of the day will be published on the booking page. We always have a wealth of speakers still TBC this year - but last year included Lat Blaylock from RE Today, Jen Jenkins from Coventry SACRE and the national RE Council project on Worldviews curriculum, Jane Kelly and Sarah Bareaud led workshops on Deep Thinking in RE, Avoiding Unconscious Bias, and Humanism from EYFS to KS3.**

The conference is focused on providing Creative approaches to teaching in schools. It covers EYFS to A Level. The cost of a ticket is subsidised through a grant from Sarum St Michael's Education Charity and therefore costs **only £60 per attendee including VAT**. This entitles you to access recordings of workshops and course materials for 10 months. Not to be missed!
